SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Perform light maintenance duties for office, retail, parking and public areas in such a manner as to create maximum tenant satisfaction and efficient use of resources. Assist the Building Engineers in the execution of repairs and preventive maintenance tasks as directed. Responds to building-related emergency calls from tenants, owners or security personnel. Assist in janitorial duties as needed in conjunction with the Day Porter.

BASIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Must obtain and maintain 07 electrical trainee card/journeyman card in an active status, including attending classes for Continuing Education during and off hours to comply with State requirements.
- Participate in maintenance of building HVAC systems, electrical systems, plumbing, preventive maintenance, building automations, door & lock hardware, safety, and janitorial requirements.
- Participate in team activities including adjustments of energy management, security surveillance and fire/life safety systems, fire drills, emergency drills.
- Perform various routine maintenance and repair tasks including changing lighting fixtures, ballasts, lamps, and repairing plumbing such as flush cartridges, instant hot water units, faucets, drain maintenance, and some piping repairs. Also, outdoor tasks such as leaf, snow, and ice removal.
- Operate motorized cart to relocate trash bins.
- Position requires occasional overtime to complete maintenance tasks.
- Ensure general cleanliness of all shops, storage and mechanical areas.
- Demonstrate a willingness to improve current skill level and develop expertise in new technical areas as required in particular buildings or circumstances.
- Ensure that work orders and preventive maintenance tasks are completed, logged and closed.

ENERGY & ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

- Adhere to energy management objectives by performing all duties in a manner consistent with sound environmental stewardship/energy management practices.
- Actively support company programs on energy management.
